CLASSES

Robins- This week in the Robins Class, we have been continuing our work on doubling and halving. We are getting very good at sharing numbers between two people. We are very excited about our trip to the farm next week and have enjoyed exploring the small world farm in the classroom. Our end of year class photograph was an exciting experience!! The Reception children spent Wednesday afternoon in Year 1 as part of their transition.

Goldfinches - This week in Goldfinches we learned about the ocean as a habitat and animals that live in the ocean. We talked about how humans impact the ocean and how best we can live harmoniously alongside it and protect Earth. In maths we continued with numbers to 100 and measuring. We had the reception children visit us again to learn our routines and class rules. We painted salt dough, decorated our Goldfinch Class letters and discussed what Kindness means as part of our values.

Kingfishers - In Kingfishers this week we have loved starting not one but two new books. We have looked reading and learning all about Africa, in our new guided reading text, Africa, Amazing Africa. In English, we have loved reading Sparky, a lovely narrative about a lazy but very friendly pet sloth. We have also been practising and getting ready for our class assembly – collecting all the learning that we cannot wait to show off from this academic year. In History, we have been Wowed by learning all about Boudicca and her amazing history with the Romans, and how inspiring she has been to everyone and even us now. We also researched and looked at Hadrian's wall and how incredible it is, and to even stand still today – we asked some really great questions as Historians that moved the learning further and helped us to find out even more and understand even more about that time in history.

Woodpeckers - This week we have been working on our narrative writing based on the book Rumaysa. The children are using the skills they have learnt this term to produce a story about a dream that Rumaysa is having whilst being locked away in her tower. Everyone has shown some amazing imagination, and I look forward to seeing their best versions next week. This week we have also begun preparations for our class assembly. I don't want to spoil what we are doing but needless to say I have been extremely impressed by our early rehearsals.
